TESTIMONIES OF GRACE



*Riley Pietzyk was baptized
on May 31, 2026.*

“I grew up going to Indian Hills since the day I was born to Jerry and Michelle Pietzyk. From a very early age I was labeled as a good kid and no one really ever questioned if I was saved or not. When I was in junior high, I started going to JHAM (Junior High Alive Ministry) and remember Jeff Harford teaching through Revelation. I was scared to death that the Rapture was going to happen and I was going to be left behind, but I never told anyone as I didn't want to let anyone down by admitting that I wasn't truly saved. That fear of the Rapture continued until the start of my freshman year when I just started lying to myself that everything would be fine because I loved Jesus, not realizing that He wasn't actually in my heart or Master of my life.

“Eventually, after the Lord put some trials in my life, I started to realize that I wasn't actually saved, as I had so much anger towards God for letting me go through them. I wanted to please myself on the inside but still continue to look like a good “Christian” on the

outside. Fast forward to the summer leading into my senior year of high school. We were at Ascend Camp listening to H. B. Charles teaching on the window in our hearts, and I remember feeling almost sick to my stomach about what actually mattered in my heart, as it definitely wasn't God. I wrestled with that pit in my stomach for the rest of the day until we had our worship time later that night. We sang a few songs and then had some time to pray on our own. That night, on June 28, 2022, I asked God to be the only thing that mattered in my life and repented of all my past sins. We were supposed to continue singing songs, but I couldn't get the words to come out as tears slid down my face knowing that I was truly a child of God now.

“As the years have gone on, I have encountered many stumbling blocks and have stumbled plenty of times along the way but am learning daily to trust in God and choose Him as the Master of my life and heart. ” ♦

“Growing up, I was raised between two different households, and I only attended church with one side of my family. As I got older, I slowly drifted further away from the Lord. I stopped going to church, and over time I began carrying a lot of anger, sadness, and feelings of being unwanted. Instead of seeking God, I pulled away from Him and tried to deal with everything on my own.

“During my senior year of high school, I started becoming curious about church again. I attended a few services with my friend and her family, and sometimes with my aunt and uncle. Even though I was still unsure about where I stood with God, those experiences planted a seed in my heart and made me start thinking more deeply about faith.

“When I moved to Nebraska, I started attending a youth Bible study, but because of my work schedule, I still wasn’t able to regularly attend church on Sundays. In January, I started going to AO, and that is where I truly began wanting to know Jesus personally and not just know about Him.

“One night at AO, I was listening to Andrew talk with someone, and I

remember him asking me when I was saved. I never answered the question out loud, but something shifted in my heart. For the first time, I fully realized that I was a sinner in need of salvation and that I needed Jesus.

“That night, I went home and prayed for the first time in a long time. That was the night I was saved. I repented of my sins and placed my faith in Christ. I felt God changing my heart and drawing me closer to Him. After that, my desire to grow in faith became stronger. I wanted to attend church consistently, so I even changed jobs so I could start going on Sundays.

“Over the last few months, I’ve felt the anger and sadness that once weighed me down fade. Instead, I’ve developed a deeper desire to become more Christ-like and to build my life around God instead of worldly things. I know I still have a lot to learn and grow in, but I want to continue surrendering my life to the Lord and following Him faithfully.

“I want to be baptized because I want to publicly declare my faith in Jesus Christ and celebrate the new life He has given me.” ♦

Hailey Schroer was baptized on May 31, 2026.

"I was fortunate enough to grow up in this church, in a Bible believing home surrounded by faithful and loving people. Sadly, growing up being taught what I should know and how I should act did not transfer into understanding the true relationship I was seeking to have with God. I had prayed for forgiveness numerous times throughout my life with no change in behavior. My final false profession of faith came in the 6th grade, completely out of fear as Jeff Harford taught the reality of end times for sinners through the book of Revelation. I initially felt relieved and worked to change how I acted over the next couple months, but I quickly slid back into bad habits and living for myself. I questioned my faith frequently but tried desperately to justify my doubt with thoughts like, 'Surely no unbeliever is questioning their faith, it must just be a moment of weakness.' I fooled myself with thoughts like these for four years.

"Sophomore year came around, and I still had the same doubts, but did well acting the part. I was forced to face my denial on our high school ski trip. Through conversations on the ski lift, God used Luke Pietzyk, one of our

many phenomenal high school sponsors, to help me see my lack of confidence in my salvation for the first time. His response was encouraging, but confirmed what I already knew—I wasn't truly saved.

"Coming home from ski-trip my life remained unchanged, but in increasing spiritual turmoil. A couple of months later came high school camp. The theme was 'All In' which finally cut deep enough for me to understand that I was not living a life that was 'All In' for Jesus Christ and that I wanted to. On the third night of camp, I accepted Jesus as my Lord and Savior. I felt an unmatched joy that night and a complete change in direction for my life. I still struggle with sin, but there is a distinct difference—now I see when those sins sneak into my life and I feel a deep guilt and need for forgiveness. My struggles with sin have also helped me to help others who find themselves in similar situations. In God's sovereignty, I have had the pleasure to hear Jeff Harford preach through Revelation again—now as a sponsor in the junior high ministry—and am pleased to no longer feel fear, but rather excitement for the promised future as one of God's Children" ♦
