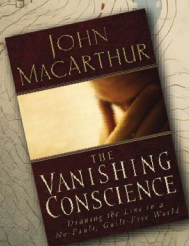

BAPTISM

TESTIMONIES OF GRACE



*Debbie Brandon was baptized
on August 23, 2026.*

"My name is Debbie Brandon. Most of you know me as a smiling face and friendly voice at the front desk here at IHCC. I was born in North Dakota and had a normal life with my mom, dad, and two brothers, although we moved a few times, taking us to Omaha, back to North Dakota, then to Lincoln. Religion wasn't really a part of my upbringing. At an early age my grandmother taught me some very basic prayers when we would visit them. They would always pray before meals and at bedtime. When I was in sixth grade, my parents began going to a Methodist church. In seventh grade, I received confirmation and was baptized the same day as my dad. I attended there off and on until my early adult years and later went to Southgate United Methodist Church.

"In 1991, I married my first husband at the Methodist Church. After 11 years of marriage, we were blessed with a miracle baby, Grace, on Christmas Day. We were very active in our Lutheran church, attending Bible studies, going to Mexico on a mission trip, and various

other ministries. Grace was baptized there. After some twists and turns, including a move to Missouri and then back here to Lincoln, our family joined the Catholic Church. Due to some serious issues in our marriage, we divorced in 2014 after 23 years.

"In 2015 I married my husband, Timothy. In this union I was blessed with a beautiful stepchild, Dani. Tim and I couldn't marry in the Catholic Church with their policies and being denied annulment of our first marriages.

"This is when I really struggled. I felt that I would never see Heaven and I would be destined to Hell forever. One day, however, I was sharing this with a new work friend. We talked about our religion and our love for God. My friend Thushara shared with me the truth of the Gospel. She told me that I do not have to confess my sins to a priest. She said that I should confess directly to Jesus and that if I am sincere about my confessed sins, my sins would be forgiven. She reminded me that this is why Jesus died on the cross. Soon after that, I chose to leave the Catholic Church.

"Not knowing where to go, I struggled on Sunday mornings for six months. Also, not attending church with my husband made me feel sad and is still hard on our marriage. Tim is a mail carrier, and on one of his routes, he met Dan McGerr. Dan shared the gospel with Tim and told him that he attends Indian Hills. Tim then suggested that I

check Indian Hills out. In the fall of 2022, I began attending here and from that first Sunday onward I cannot even begin to express the love, encouragement and support I have received through sermons, the SISTERS ministry, and Bible studies. I have been truly blessed by such incredible people and a faithful church.

"Some people know the exact date when they were saved. Looking back on all that God has done for me, I don't think I can pinpoint the exact date when the Lord gave me new life, but I know that He did. I recognize my sin and my need for a Savior to pay my debt. I wholeheartedly believe in Christ as that Savior. By His grace, I've turned away from my sins and now I have a personal relationship with the Lord and

seek to live according to His Word every day. I know I can lean on the Lord for all things now, and that He is there for me. He knows my sins of yesterday, today, and tomorrow. Christ gave His life for me so I can have eternal life with Him always.

"Psalm 34:18, 'The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit.'" ♦
