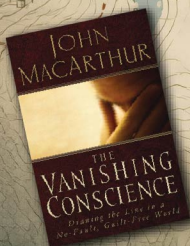

TESTIMONIES OF GRACE



Emily Kobza was baptized on September 13, 2026.

"Hi, my name is Emily Kobza. I have an amazing husband, Kaylob Kobza and two boys, three-year-old Kaynen and seven-month-old Kashten.

"I was born and raised here in Lincoln. From a young age until I was ten years old, I attended church with my mom and grandparents every Sunday, as well as some Wednesdays. When I was ten, my grandpa passed away. He was my light. It really took a toll on my mom and I, and we stopped attending church.

"Now we fast-forward through the years until a couple of months ago, the day my husband and I were saved on July 11, 2026. At that time, Kaylob wasn't actually my husband. We had been living together for years, and we had even started a family together, but more on that later.

"I had a deep sense of despair and longing which I had been experiencing for quite awhile. I didn't recognize myself anymore. My positivity, happiness, hard work ethic, kind heart, care, and determination had all started to slip away. Anger, annoyance, and anxiety was consuming my day-to-day life. It was uncharacteristic of me, and it was affecting me as a partner, a mother, a friend and an employee. I was lost.

I didn't know who I was anymore. But a little piece of my heart still had hope.

"One day I was talking to two people who inspire me, and who I knew to have a strong love for Jesus Christ—my best friend, AshLynn Romero, and my boss, Lincoln Pearson. I didn't know where to start, but I wanted to know more about Jesus. They shared how much He can do in my life if I surrender my life to Him, and how amazing and good He is. AshLynn and her husband invited us to attend church with them here at Indian Hills. We came to Indian Hills, and were amazed. Later, I was talking to my boss about it and he helped us get into contact with Pastor Jesse to set up a meeting.

"During that meeting, I expressed to Pastor Jesse that I truly wanted to be saved. I wanted to give myself up and become a new creation by putting all of my faith in Jesus. A few days later, on July 11, Kaylob joined me to meet with Pastor Jesse. And there, after we heard the gospel and expressed our belief in the gospel, we both gave our lives to Christ.

"Though it was just two months ago, there has already been a lot of change in my life. First of all, six days after committing our lives to Christ, Kaylob and I got married, on July 17. Since then, we've been regularly attending church services here at Indian Hills. I've met women here at the church who are mentoring and guiding me, and we're going through a book about biblical marriage with Pastor Jesse and Benjamin Buhr.

"I truly feel like I have found a better me! A new creation, a baby believer, walking in newness of life with my full trust and faith in Jesus Christ, my Savior." ♦



Kaylob Kobza was baptized on September 13, 2026.

"My name is Kaylob Kobza and I am the husband to my beautiful wife, Emily, and father to our two boys, Kaynen and Kashten.

"Growing up, my family was not involved in any church and we moved around a lot. From Alliance, Nebraska, to Lincoln, to Columbus. I didn't have my father in my life until I was 15, and I was causing so much trouble for my mom—a single mother with two boys— that she didn't know what else to do with us. Not having a stable home or stable friendships was the norm. It was common for me to not get too close to people because I knew those relationships would never be permanent. This led to me growing numb toward caring for others, and even for myself. On top of that, I despised and resented my father.

"Up until July 11, 2026, I lived a life of darkness, a life which was void of the Holy Spirit. I indulged in a number of different sins that not only hurt myself, but caused hurt to the people around me. I chose to drink as a way to drown my problems, but that only created new ones. The entire time I thought I was doing things the right way and did my best in the only manner I knew how. But, with no one to guide me, and without the Holy Spirit in me, everything I tried to do was only a temporary fix, and I always felt unfulfilled. I

was drifting farther and farther away from God, and I didn't even realize it.

"Earlier this year, my wife (who wasn't yet my wife) and I were at a difficult point in our relationship. We were hurting, and that's what brought us to Indian Hills. On July 11, after Pastor Jesse explained the gospel to us, I asked God to save me. And in that moment, with tears coming down my face, I felt a sense of peace, and I knew everything was going to be okay.

"Since that day, my wife and I have been learning what it means to walk in obedience to our Savior. Emily and I got married six days after giving our lives to Christ. We are learning and understanding what a biblical marriage is and how to live with one another with biblical love. We've been attending Indian Hills regularly on Sundays. On a personal level, I don't get easily frustrated with people driving down the road or feel that need to drink that I once did.

"I owe a lot of gratitude to my mentor, Benjamin Buhr, who has been a great encouragement in my life and who God is using to teach me, to answer my questions, and to help understand the growth I need from the Bible and to help me understand what Christ is saying to me through His Word.

"I ultimately owe all my thanks to God, who is working in not just me, but also through my wife. I'm truly blessed and honored to continue on my journey to know Christ better." ♦
