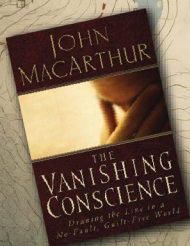

# BAPTISM

## TESTIMONIES OF GRACE



*Lucas Garton was baptized on September 20, 2026.*

"My name is Lucas Garton. I have been attending Indian Hills for a little more than a year and I was born in Lincoln, NE. When I was four, I was put into foster care due to my biological father's history of abuse with my brothers and me. After four years of supervised visits and court proceedings, it was determined that returning to my biological parents' care would not be a viable option.

"Thankfully, the people that had been fostering my brothers and I decided that they would adopt us and make us a permanent part of their home. It was during this time that I was taken to church for the first time. I remember participating in AWANA and my local youth group all the way up through high school. But it was just something I attended and did 'good' at because that's what I thought made me a good person to other people. I didn't have a genuine relationship with God, although I would say I was a Christian and claim to be saved.

"My parents legally split and later divorced while I was in high school, and the cracks in the facade I had put on really started to show. By the time I got to college,

there was no facade at all. I was living in direct opposition to how God would want me to live. I wanted to be the life of the party and cared only about what I wanted, with no regard for the people around me. But, all it did was leave me with a feeling of emptiness and despair.

"By the grace of God, He put Ray Schneider in my life when he married my mom in 2016. He started pushing and prodding me about my relationship with Christ. He saw through my facade and called me out about how my life did not align with who I claimed to be.

"It was through these conversations and ultimately the pull of the Holy Spirit that I decided to give my life to Christ and started pursuing a genuine relationship with Christ.

"Since giving my life to Christ, I can say that there has been real change in my life. I am no longer dead in sin and living for myself, but rather living for Christ. I have a desire to study and learn about God's Word as well as getting involved at church through my small group and men's equipping group. I know the road ahead won't be easy, but I have full confidence in God and what He has done for me." ♦

*Jenny Lavalleur was baptized

"I grew up attending Indian Hills with faithful parents. I always heard the gospel, but it went in one ear and out the other. As I grew older, I became more curious about what the world had to offer. I was surrounding myself with unbelieving friends, but still had an underlying feeling that I should go to church on Sundays, because growing up that was what I did, but as an adult I'd find an excuse to not go.

"As time went on, I started experimenting with drugs, going out to bars, clubs, and ultimately letting sin take control over my life. It wasn't until I started struggling financially that I felt I needed a change. I needed God. I've always believed in Jesus, but I never accepted Him. I remember sitting at the kitchen table with my parents and them leading me through 'the prayer,' and I thought that I had surrendered my life to Christ. After that, I started going back to church, but as time

went on, I started stumbling back into my old habits. I lived for my own pleasure, only turning to God when something went wrong. It wasn't until my late twenties that I started slowing down and getting more serious.

"I tried going to AA/NA meetings and relied on my unbelieving friends for their guidance because they appeared to have their lives 'together,' but nothing truly helped. I was confused and lost; I couldn't figure out why I struggled so much.

"I remember my parents telling me 'when you make God your focus, everything comes together.' That night, I prayed to God, asking for His forgiveness and begging for His help. I felt a change in my heart, and since then, I have felt conviction when my old sinful habits try to sneak back into my life. I have found ways to be involved in church and to develop relationships with other believers. I now hunger to be in His Word, and I have found the peace I was longingly searching for all this time." ♦
